

Preparing for an ‘Audiology Training Program‘

A Pakistan-Hilfe zur Selbsthilfe e.V. team is preparing for an 'Audiology Training Program' to be held in November at HASHIM WELFARE HOSPITAL.

During the annual Free Ear Camps, the focus is on examining patients and adjusting hearing aids. There is no time for intensive training of hospital staff. So it remains for them to learn while observing the work of the team from GERMANY and through brief information about procedures and temporary assistance.

Because the HASHIM WELFARE HOSPITAL will have to be able to independently diagnose hearing impaired people, to program and adjust hearing aids and to perform aftercare from 2022 on, it will now be important to qualify the hospital's staff.

The aim of the program in November is to give selected staff of the hospital, without the a free ear camp workload, the opportunity for concentrated and focused education and training.

Chairman PHzSH e.V. Hans Joachim Gerber and the two acousticians Heinke Hedler and Michael Eggers will be in PINDI HASHIM for eight days



Michael Eggers will train Malik Nadeem Awan in milling ear molds, programming and adapting hearing aids.



Heinke Hedler will teach Maryam basics on audiology and train her in Newborn Hearing Screening.



In addition to education and training, after six months of planning work for the construction of an annex to the hospital, in which the an ENT DEPARTMENT will be set up with medical equipment donated from GERMANY, for Dr. Idress Awan (Chairman HASHIM WELFARE ASSOCIATION) and Hans Joachim Gerber (Chairman PHzSH e.V) the start of construction works will be on the agenda.
